Enclosed is an application, dated August 21, 2013, received by the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission, from Rapiscan Systems, Inc., requesting amendment No. 02 to its existing license, XB1329/01. The license presently authorizes the export to Iraq of 1,000 explosive detection devices containing a total of 740 MBq Am-241 foil source, for demonstration to the Iraqi military.

The purpose of the amendment is to remove the existing other U.S. party and add two new U.S. parties to the list.

Since no substantive changes to the terms and conditions of the existing license are requested, our office is processing this as minor amendment. Therefore, the NRC intends to issue the license amendment after the required 30-day review period.
