

SUBJECT: Use of Land/Facility in and around the Annapolis Police Department facility

The Department of the Army, with assistance from U. S. Department of Energy (DOE) prime contractors, provides training with federal, state, and local government agencies, and to other entities, in the area of radiological dispersion devices and instrumentation testing. The Department of the Army is requesting this training.

This Memorandum of Agreement is to document the following items regarding the training for the requesting entities.

1. For the duration of the training for the requesting entities, the APD agrees to the use and storage of DOE radiological material sources at the APD facility located at 199 Taylor Ave., Annapolis, MD 21401. When not in use for the training, the radiological material sources will be secured in a locked area or locked storage container at the facility, as coordinated between the APD and DOE or DOE's prime contractor assisting with the training and the handling of the material sources.
2. DOE, or a DOE prime contractor acting at DOE's request, will provide for radiological controls and mitigation measures during the training in accordance with DOE's or the prime contractor's procedures.
3. The APD agrees to permit the use of their facilities/range as necessary or appropriate for the purpose of conducting the training activities with the requesting entities.
