Status of Recommendations

Recommendation 1: Update Management Directive 14.1 to clearly identify premium travel authorizing officials; clarify “Delegation of Authority” and require this to be in written form; and clarify the 14-hour rule, specifically the rest period.

Agency Response Dated
August 16, 2013:

Management Directive 14.1 *Official Temporary Duty Travel* has been revised to incorporate these changes and was sent to NRC offices for comments. Comments were received and have been evaluated by the Office of the Chief Financial Officer (OCFO). The updated management directive has been approved by the Office of the Executive Director for Operations (OEDO) and is now in the Chairman’s office for final review and approval. The OCFO considers *Recommendation 1* resolved.

OIG Analysis: The proposed action meets the intent of the recommendation. OIG will close this recommendation when the agency provides a copy of the updated management directive and OIG determines that it clearly identifies premium travel authorizing officials; clarifies “Delegation of Authority” and requires it to be in written form; and clarifies the 14-hour rule, specifically the rest period.
