Materials Licensing Branch:

As part of the annual review of the University of Michigan - Radiation Safety Program, I recently identified a few typographical errors and misaligned dates on recent license amendments.

Amendment No. 97

Condition 28(B) in Amendment No. 97 indicates that the changes made to the license were a result of submitted correspondences dated February 27, 2012 and March 19, 2012 (bold print). However, in Section 3 of the license (Page 1 of 10) it incorrectly states: 'In accordance with letter dated January 20, 2012'.

Amendment No. 99 and Amendment No. 100

Condition 28(B) in Amendment No. 99 correctly identifies that changes were made to the license in accordance with the requested changes in a correspondence dated August 9, 2012. The change requested approval for the use of Ra-223. This was accurately reflected in Section 3 of the license (Page 1 of 10).

However, in Condition 28(B) of Amendment No. 100, the date of August 9, 2012 was apparently inadvertently deleted from the list of letters reviewed and approved by the NRC.

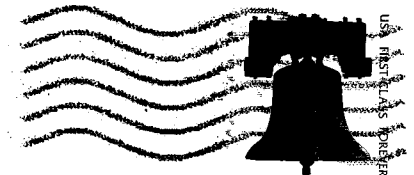
