Enclosed is an application (XSOU8830), dated August 21, 2013, received by the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission, from Cotter Corporation, for the export of 16,000,000 kilograms (kgs) of caldasite ore, containing 34,000 kgs of natural uranium (U_3O_8) and 11,200 kgs of thorium (ThO_2) to Dalian V Mineral Co., Ltd. in China for non-nuclear end-uses.

Inasmuch as Executive Branch views and/or assurance letters are not required for export of this material, our office intends to issue the license after the required waiting period.
