In order to support the termination request for the above listed license, we need the following additional information:

2. Provide documentation of sealed source transfer/receipt from Monongalia General Hospital, and the most recent leak tests for all sealed sources demonstrating there has been no leakage. This may include dose calibrator sources (barium, cesium, and cobalt), camera check sources (cobalt, germanium, cesium), and well counter and survey instrument check sources (cesium).
3. With regards to the facility diagram and closeout surveys, please provide the actual locations for the number listings on the diagram provided.
4. The termination request letter submitted was signed by you, and did not indicate a title. Previous correspondence was signed by Darrell F. Saunders, Jr., M.D., and listed him as the Chief Executive Officer (CEO); and the website for Morgantown Internal Medicine Group lists the same. In order to complete termination of this license, please confirm that you are a senior management representative of this facility and indicate your title. Otherwise, please have a senior management representative review and confirm that they are in agreement with the information provided in this response and the letter dated June 10, 2013 the current CEO.
5. Please confirm that telephone numbers provided in the request for medical physics consultant, Mark T. Perna, is for business and can be made publicly available.
