Dear Mr. Quinton:

This refers to (1) your May 29, 2013, letter requesting the addition of a radium-223 dichloride authorization to your NRC License No. 13-26246-01MD, (2) your July 9, 2013 email, and (3) our August 26, 2013, telephone conversation. During our phone conversation, you indicated that you understood that U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) review of radium-223 dichloride use at commercial radiopharmacy licensee facilities is ongoing. The NRC expects to have radiopharmacy radium-223 dichloride licensing criteria established in the near future.

As discussed in our phone conversations, we have voided your request for a radioactive materials license. This action is without prejudice to resubmission. **If you resubmit your request, please describe your planned use for radium-223 dichloride. Attach additional information describing any radium-223 dichloride-specific facilities, equipment, radiation safety program, or waste management, which differ substantively from information submitted in your most recent radioactive materials renewal application dated February 15, 2011. Attach a current, signed, dated cover letter to your resubmitted request.**
