Dear Mr. Reichard,

First. Let me express my sincere appreciation for your patience as we work through this transitional period. As you are aware our former RSO, Chris Rea accepted a different position within the Agency in June of this year. He agreed to stay on as RSO and help us through this period until we were able to determine a short term strategy following his departure.

In light of Mr. Rea's departure we have determined that we would like John Domey to assume the RSO duties for the Vermont Agency of Transportation. He has successfully completed safety classes on the use and transport of the nuclear gauges. He has also recently conducted leak tests under the observation and guidance of the past RSO. I believe that John meets the minimum qualifications as outlined in NUREG-1556, Vol 1, Rev. 1. In addition, we have arranged for John to attend the Applied Health Physics RSO training in Bethel Park, PA from October 7 -9, 2013.

We also reviewed our gauge storage locations and after an internal discussion we have determined that the following locations should be listed as storage locations:

1. Central Garage Berlin: 1716 Barre-Montpelier Road, RT 302, Berlin, VT 05461
2. District # 5 Colchester: 769 Barnes Avenue, Colchester VT 05446
3. District # 7 St. Johnsbury: 1068 US Route 5, Suite 2, St. Johnsbury, Vermont 05819
4. District # 4 White River Junction: 221 Beswick Drive, White River Junction, Vermont 05001
5. District # 3 Rutland: 122 State Place, Rutland, VT 05701
6. Materials and Research 2178 Airport Rd, Building B, Berlin, VT 05641

The District 5 facility underwent some changes – the Agency built some different buildings and moved some people around. The physical location changes within the compound generated a different 911 address for the gauge storage location; we've included that herein and confirmed the addresses of the remaining locations.

We appreciate your offer to walk our staff through this process. For example, what steps remain for us to resolve so as to keep our license in good standing and for us to receive our license with the updated information? As John Domey [(802) 828-6914] is our RSO I think it would be most efficient to coordinate any available assistance directly through him. Donal Morris [(802) 828-6923] is his supervisor and can often reach John when he is in the field especially if you need an immediate action or response to a particular item. Please feel free to contact Donal if/when necessary. I have copied both individuals on this e-mail so that you will their e-mail addresses.

Please do not hesitate to contact me directly with any questions if you're unable to contact John or Donal for some reason or if you need immediate follow-up or communication. I am more than happy to work with you to maintain VTrans compliance with the provisions of our license.
