Information requested: Our review of the training and experience for 10 CFR 35.300 included in the 313A (AUT) indicated the physician has a total of 80 hours of classroom and lab training [ref. Item 3 on NRC Form 313A (AUT)] while we require a total of 700 hours of training and experience, including a minimum of 200 hours of classroom and laboratory training in basic radionuclide handling techniques applicable to the medical use of unsealed byproduct material requiring a written directive [please refer to 10 CFR 35.390 (b)(1) for additional details].
