This is in reference to your application dated July 25, 2013 requesting to renew Nuclear Regulatory Commission License No. 44-14121-01. In order to continue our review, we need the following additional information. As stated in the notice of expiration which was sent to you and explained on the phone to your Radiation Safety Officer, James Rademacher, M.D., on September 5, 2013, we reserve the right to request a complete, up-to-date application in cases where licenses have been amended frequently or are supported by a large number of fragmented or disjointed documents. We have reviewed your submission and existing license and request that you submit a single, complete application using the guidance provided in Appendix C of NUREG 1156 Vol 9 Rev 2 (<http://pbadupws.nrc.gov/docs/ML0734/ML073400289.pdf>) and as directed on the NRC form 313 application in sections 5 through 11.
