C/N's 318192 (pharmacy) and 318193 (cyclotron)

SUMMARY

I contacted Mr. Rozycki and informed him that we had pursued Spectron's request to reconsider his concern regarding the Part 30 App. B value for cobalt-57 that pushes their cyclotron license into the requirement to have financial assurance.

This issue was brought up by another <sup>applicant</sup> application for a cyclotron license. We discussed the issue with our HQ office and they indicated that they were aware of the concern as communicated to them by other licensees, but a change in the App B value would require a rulemaking change, which is a lengthy process even if NRC decides to go down that path.

I will review Spectron's 12/14/09 response to my 10/15/09 telephone deficiency for both the pharmacy and cyclotron applications, but cannot issue the licenses until FA gets approved.

I also informed Mr. Rozycki that based on my review of their cyclotron application and calculations, Spectron will be required to submit a decommissioning funding plan. Their possession limits for cobalt-57 and zinc-65 exceed the value for requiring a DFP for the cyclotron license.

I will evaluate whether or not the pharmacy license can be issued before the cyclotron license can be issued after I verify that it does not require FA

After review of Spectron's pharmacy application, I confirmed that Spectron will need to submit FA for this license as well due to the requested possession limit for 1 curie of Ge-68 (T1/2 = 288 days).
