In response to Defense Nuclear Facilities Safety Board (DNFSB) Recommendation 2012-1, *Savannah River Site Building 235-F Safety*, DOE has prepared a Basis for Interim Operation (BIO) and an associated implementation plan. The BIO documents the safety basis for the Surveillance and Maintenance (S&M) of Building 235-F at the Savannah River Site, while the implementation plan specifies the DOE actions for addressing DNFSB Recommendation 2012-1.

Shaw AREVA MOX Services has performed a review of the BIO and implementation plan. MOX Services has completed revisions to documents supporting the Integrated Safety Analysis Summary (ISAS) for external hazards. Based on the BIO and implementation plan, MOX Services has determined that the external hazards analysis and ISAS conclusions remain valid.
