1. Please note by increasing the total maximum possession limit for licensed material identified in Item 6.B. may require the implementation of Increased Controls (ICs). In addition, please note that the licensee shall comply with the requirements for "Increased Controls for Licensees that Possess Sources Containing Radioactive Material Quantities of Concern" (IC) (Accession No. ML053130364) as Attachment B to the "Order Imposing Increased Controls" (ADAMS Accession No. ML053130218) published in the Federal Register on December 1, 2005 (70 FR 72128); and with the "Order Imposing Fingerprinting and Criminal History Records Check Requirements for Unescorted Access to Certain Radioactive Materials" (Fingerprinting Order) (ADAMS Accession No. ML073230831) published in the Federal Register on December 13, 2007 (72 FR 70901). The licensee shall complete implementation of said requirements by the first day that radionuclides in quantities of concern are possessed at or above the limits specified in "Table 1: Radionuclides of Concern" contained within the Fingerprinting Order. Notwithstanding any provisions of the Commission's regulations to the contrary, all measures implemented or actions taken in response to these Orders shall be maintained until the Commission orders otherwise, or until the Commission explicitly modifies its regulations to reflect the increased controls and fingerprinting requirements, and states in modifying its regulations, that the revisions are to supersede these Orders. The licensee shall notify the Director, Office of Federal and State Materials and Environmental Management Programs, U.S. NRC, Washington, DC, 20555, in writing, within 25 days after it has completed the requirements of this condition. In addition, licensee responses applicable to this license condition shall be marked as "Withhold from Public Disclosure under 10 CFR 2.390."

Please confirm that ICs and the Fingerprinting and Criminal History Records Check Order will be implemented by the 1st day that radionuclides in quantities of concern are possessed at or above the limits specified in Table 1: Radionuclides of Concern contained within the Fingerprinting Order. If your facility or facilities will not possess radionuclides in quantities of concern at any one time or the devices will not be collocated, please so state.

 In Item 3 of NRC Form 313, you specify a new production facility as Blind Faith; however, in Item 9 supplemental information to your amendment request, you specify the new production facility as Big Foot.

Please clarify this discrepancy.
