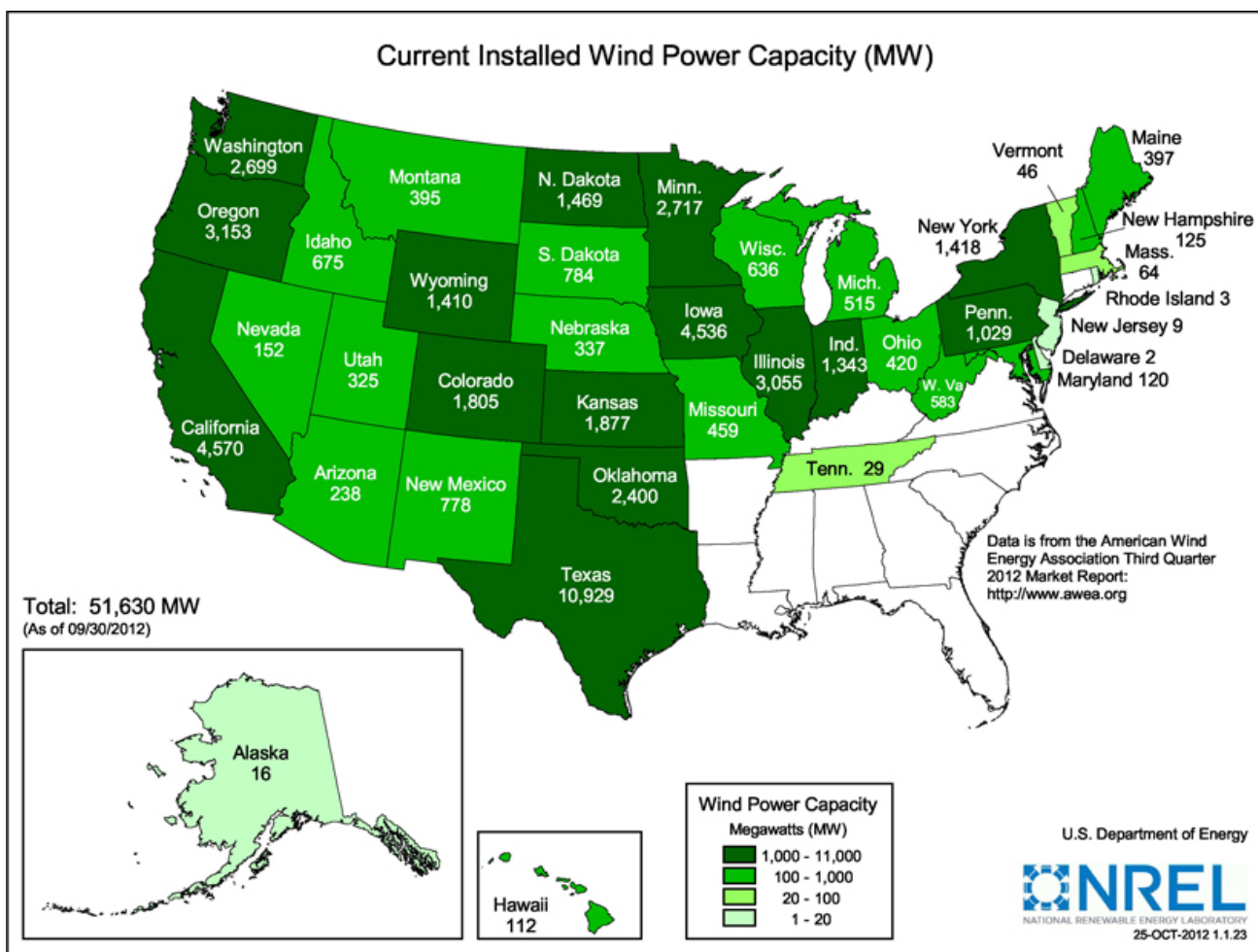

This page has maps of the United States that show installed wind capacity by state and its progression.



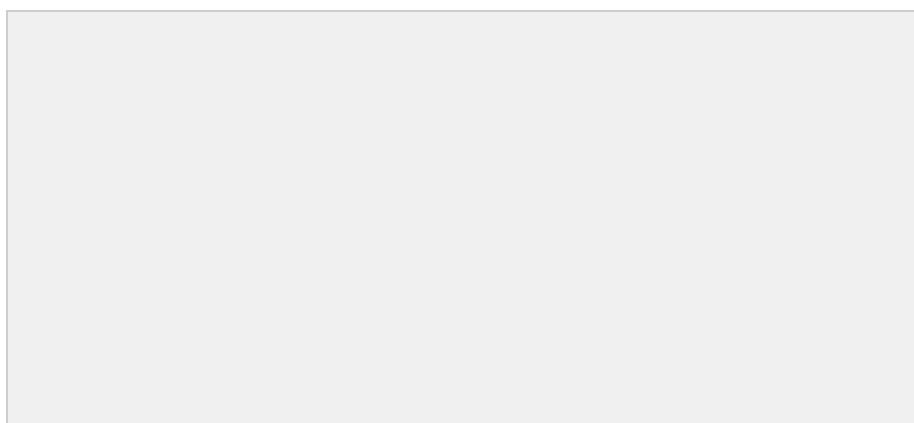

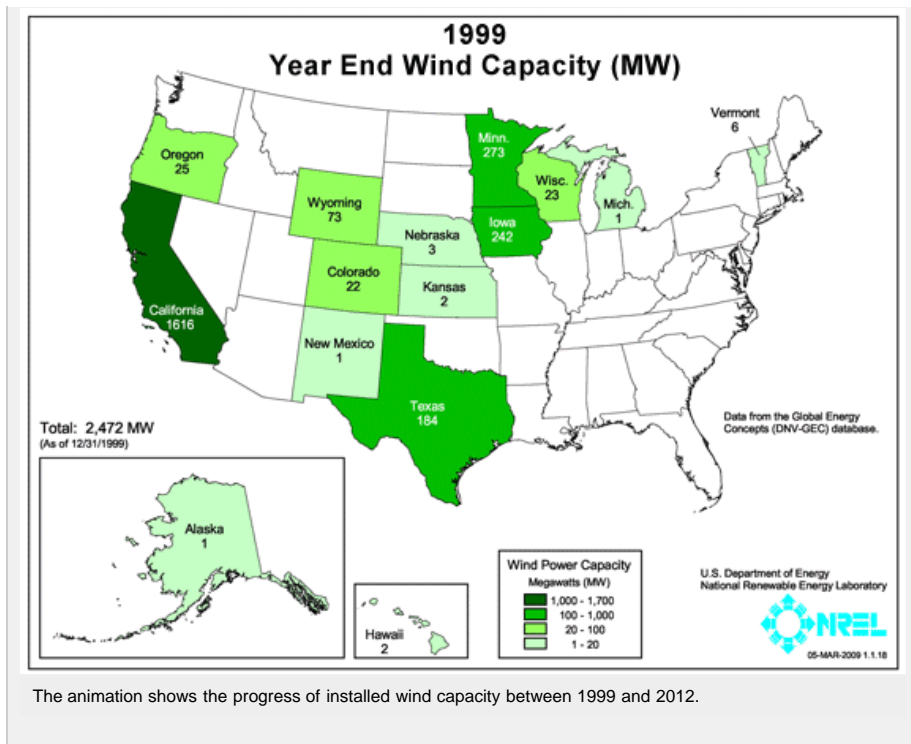

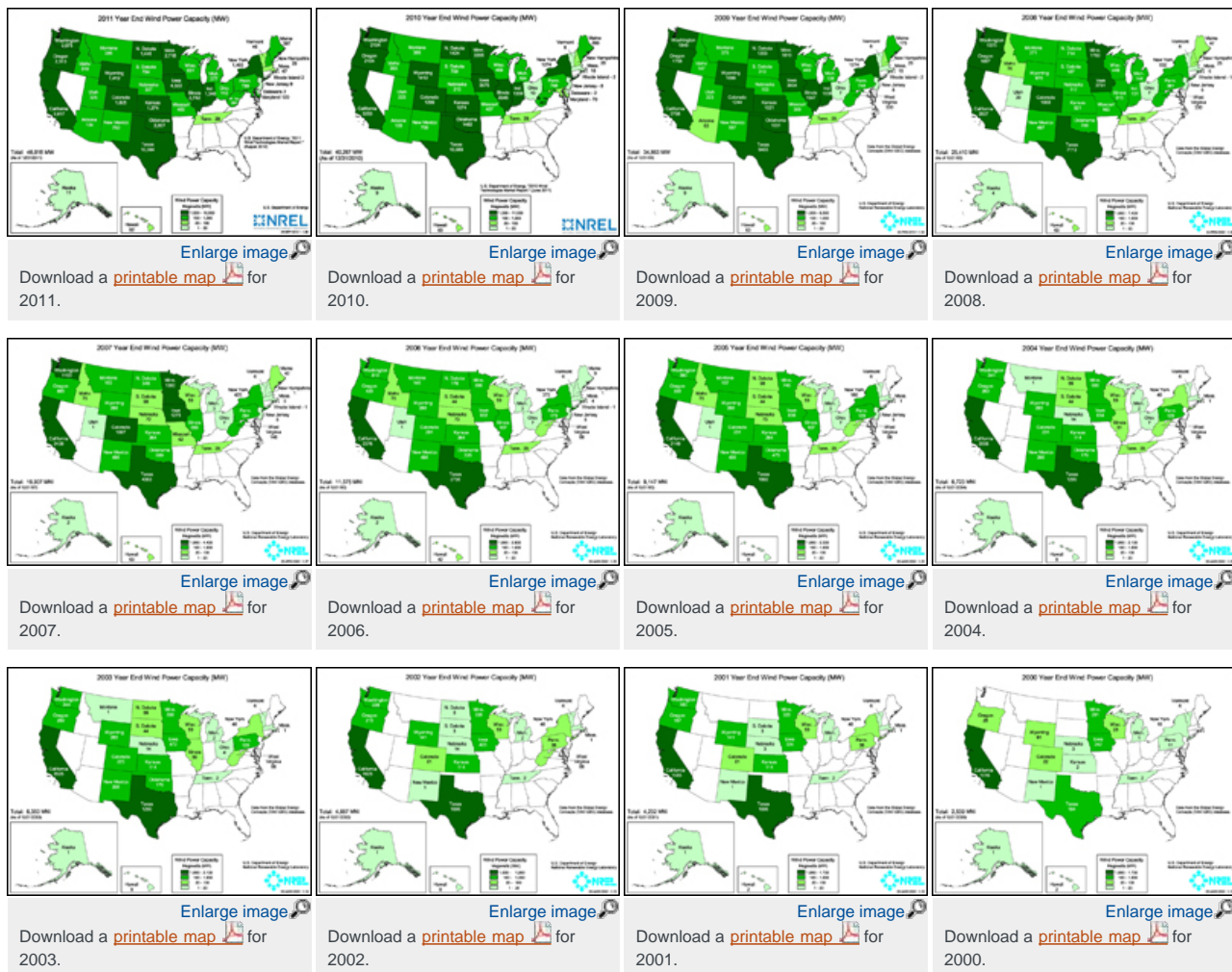

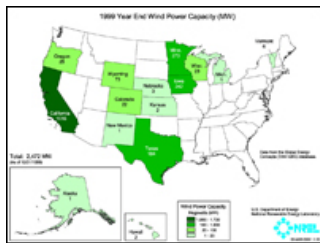
