Dear Dr. Arfken:

Enclosed is Amendment No. 24 to your NRC Material License No. 13-17449-01 in accordance with your requests dated July 1, 2013, and July 25, 2013, **with the exception of adding Surjeet Pohar, M.D., as an Authorized User (AU). Please also note that we have revised Item 8.C., and deleted Condition 13, as listed on the previous version of the license, in accordance with current licensing policy.** Changes made to your license are printed in bold font. Please review the enclosed document carefully and be sure that you understand all conditions. If there are any errors or questions, please notify the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC), Region III office at (630) 829-9887 so that we can provide appropriate corrections and answers.

As we discussed in our September 19, 2013, and September 24, 2013, phone conversations, to add Dr. Pohar as an AU, we require documentation confirming either Mr. Pohar's completion of either:

1. Dr. Pohar's completion of at least three parenteral administrations of dosages containing any beta emitter, or a photon-emitting radionuclide with a photon energy less than 150 keV, for which a written directive is required, together with an appropriate preceptor attestation, in accordance with Title 10 Code of the *Code of Federal Regulations* Section 35.390; or
2. An NRC license number or a copy of an agreement state radioactive materials license or permit confirming that Dr. Pohar has been previously authorized for the parenteral administrations of dosages containing any beta emitter, or a photon-emitting radionuclide with a photon energy less than 150 keV, for which a written directive is required.


Top add Dr. Pohar as an AU, please resubmit your request under a signed and dated cover letter, including all relevant documentation. This action is without prejudice to resubmission.

You will be periodically inspected by NRC. Failure to conduct your program in accordance with NRC regulations, license conditions, and representations made in your license application and supplemental correspondence with NRC will result in enforcement action against you. This could include issuance of a notice of violation, or imposition of a civil penalty, or an order suspending, modifying or revoking your license as specified in the General Statement of Policy and Procedure for NRC Enforcement Actions. Since serious consequences to employees and the public can result from failure to comply with NRC requirements, prompt and vigorous enforcement action will be taken when dealing with licensees who do not achieve the necessary meticulous attention to detail and the high standard of compliance which NRC expects of its licensees.

The NRC's Safety Culture Policy Statement became effective in June 2011. While a policy statement and not a regulation, it sets forth the agency's *expectations* for individuals and organizations to establish and maintain a positive safety culture.
