We have disposed of the Seaman C-200 nuclear gauge, however Seaman Nuclear Corporation has not sent us any disposal documentation. We have called them on several occasions, the most recent was August 23rd prior to today. Attached is some email correspondence from Harry Seaman informing us as to the disposal fee (page 1), our check request to our accounts payable department (page 2) and the accounts payable account status (page 3), showing that the check was cut and processed. I know that we need to submit the disposal documentation to the NRC and will as soon as we receive it.

Also attached is a copy of the leak test results for the gauge, from January 22, 2013.

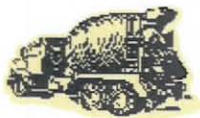
The third item in your email concerns Missoula, Montana as a location of use. We do still need to have Missoula specified as a location of use, for the remaining gauges identified in our license.
