EnergySolutions is submitting this notification to continue work at the temporary job site located at the Beltsville Agricultural Research Center's (BARC) low level radioactive burial site located near Cherry Hill Road and US Route 1/Baltimore Ave in Beltsville, MD under our newly issued mobile NRC license 41-35044-01. Work at the location has been performed under our license 06-20775-01; however, this license was terminated and the new license issued to our Oak Ridge, TN office. EnergySolutions will continue site work in accordance with the approved Decommissioning Plan for the burial site as maintained under BARC NRC License 19-00914-03 under our new license. A revised division of responsibilities agreement has been established between EnergySolutions and the Department of Agriculture in accordance with license condition 14 of the new license. A copy of this revised agreement is attached.

EnergySolutions


EnergySolutions shall be responsible for the following activities under the EnergySolutions mobile NRC Radioactive Materials D&D license, 41-35044-01:

- Monitoring project personnel and the general public,
- Waste handling, segregation and packaging,
- Waste storage and shipment,
- Final Status Surveys and site restoration.

US Department of Agriculture


The US Department of Agriculture shall be responsible for the following activities under their NRC Radioactive Materials License 19-00915-03.

- Maintaining site security and access,
- General site access training,
- Oversight of EnergySolutions remediation work,
- Monitoring of US Dept. of Agriculture and oversight personnel
- Public relations.
