RAI 398 addresses Ultimate Heat Sink, as discussed in Section 9.2.5 of the Final Safety Analysis Report (FSAR), as submitted in Part 2 of the Calvert Cliffs Nuclear Power Plant (CCNPP) Unit 3 Combined License Application (COLA), Revision 9.

UniStar Nuclear Energy requires additional time to finalize the response to RAI 398 Question 09.02.05-32. The response to RAI 398 will be provided by November 5, 2013.


