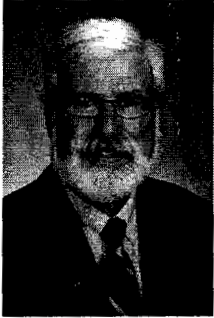
Dr. Arjun Makhijani
