I am writing in response to your request for clarification on some of the wipe test results for Building 118, Laboratory D209. The wipe samples from this area were assessed on August 30, 2000. Due to a printer ribbon issue, the results of samples 144-149 and samples 179 – 184 are difficult to read and do not show up clearly on copies or scans. The original liquid scintillation counter printouts for these samples were reviewed and while it is still difficult to read the "exact" dpm values for some of these samples, it was verified that the results for all of these samples were less than 100 dpm.
