### Action Items

- 1) GE will provide a red-line mark up version of the Sampling Plans incorporating comments from the agencies.
- 2) GE will provide a detailed schedule of the sampling event.
- 3) GE will prepare a memo or document discussing the original conceptual layouts proposed and the rationale for excluding some of them. (not needed anytime soon – can be part of the alternative analysis)
- 4) EPA will look into requirements for transporting samples across 566.
- 5) GE will prepare a table summarizing the purpose of each boring.
- 6) EPA will coordinate a conference call to ensure input from Jody Waugh who was unable to attend the meeting.
- 7) GE will prepare a chart including the various waste streams, volumes, locations, and destinations (for example, PTW, TPH, metals, other debris, etc). (not needed anytime soon – can be part of the design)
- 8) EPA will provide test results for Unnamed Arroyo #2 to Navajo Nation.
- 9) EPA will discuss groundwater contamination concerns with the Navajo Nation on September 17.
- 10) EPA will provide information to the Navajo Nation about the development of the 200 piC/g Principal Threat Waste value.
- 11) EPA will send a list of Superfund JTI trainees to GE for possible use during the sampling event.
  - 12) NRC and EPA will send approval letters after review of red-line mark up version is submitted.
