MINERALS CORPORATION 2013 ANNUAL REPORT

Dear Mr. Gieck:

In a letter dated September 26, 2013, Umetco Minerals Corporation (Umetco) submitted the annual report for your Gas Hills facility in Natrona and Fremont Counties, Wyoming (Agencywide Document Access and Management System (ADAMS) Accession Number ML13273A039). The U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) staff has completed its review of the 2013 report and do not have any comments or questions at this time.

In a letter dated September 24, 2012, the NRC staff recommended that Umetco sample all constituents with approved Alternate Concentration Limits (ACLs) at the model validation wells until the site is transferred to the U.S. Department of Energy. On March 7 and September 18, 2013, you provided the results of the sampling for ACL constituents, and included these results in the annual report. We will provide our comments on the results in your March 7 and September 18, 2013 letters separately.
