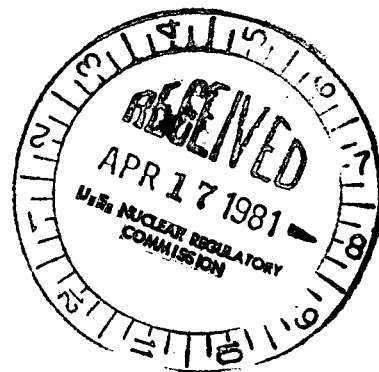

SUBJECT: SUMMARY OF SAN ONOFRE MEETING ON TOXIC GAS HAZARDS

On March 27, 1981, members of the NRC staff met with the applicants to discuss the above subject. Attendees at the meeting are given in Enclosure 1. The agenda for the meeting is given in Enclosure 2. Material presented by the applicants' consultant, Science Applications, Inc. (SAI) is given in Enclosure 3, and addresses the probability of toxic gas hazard due to truck accidents on I-5 in the vicinity of San Onofre 2 and 3. At the conclusion of the meeting, the applicants agreed to submit on the docket material addressing toxic gas hazards at San Onofre, including the SAI report which provides the basis for the applicants' conclusions, within a few days after the meeting.
