This is a request under the Freedom of Information Act (5 U.S.C. § 552).

We are requesting documents and materials created or maintained in connection with the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission's investigation of the failure of a temporary hoisting assembly that occurred on March 31, 2013, at the Arkansas Nuclear One in Russellville, Arkansas (the "March 31, 2013, event"). To assist you in identifying and locating documents and materials responsive to this request, we would note that the March 31, 2013, event is the subject of the June 7, 2013, Nuclear Regulatory Commission Augmented Inspection Team Report 05000313/2013011 and 05000368/2013011. Please provide the following:



All reports and analyses, including non-identical drafts of reports and analyses prepared in connection with the Nuclear Regulatory Commission's investigation of the March 31, 2013, event (including, but not limited to, all non-identical versions of the June 7, 2013, Nuclear Regulatory Commission Augmented Inspection Team Report 05000313/2013011 and 05000368/2013011);
2. Any internal memoranda, and discussion papers that reference the March 31, 2013, event;
3. All correspondence that references the March 31, 2013, event;

4. All photographs and videos taken in connection with the Nuclear Regulatory Commission's investigation of the March 31, 2013, event;
5. All measures, sketches, or drawings that concern the March 31, 2013, event;
6. All reports and analyses created by Entergy Operations, Inc. and provided to the Nuclear Regulatory Commission in connection with the March 31, 2013, event; and
7. All non-identical versions of any root cause evaluation reports created by Entergy Operations, Inc. and provided to the Nuclear Regulatory Commission in connection with the March 31, 2013, event (including, but not limited to, all non-identical versions of the July 22, 2013, Root Cause Evaluation Report: Unit 1 Main Turbine Generator Stator, CR-ANO-C-2013-00888; Event Date: 03-31-2013).
