By letter dated August 11, 1988 you requested a revision to the Technical Specifications (TS) for San Onofre Nuclear Generating Station (SONGS) Units 2 and 3. This change would delete both TS Section 6.5.3.4a, which requires the Nuclear Safety Group (NSG) to review the safety evaluations for (1) changes to procedures required by Specification 6.8, equipment, or systems and (2) tests or experiments completed under 10 CFR 50.59; and TS Section 6.5.3.4.g, which requires the NSG to review events requiring 24 hour written notification to the Commission. This request was identified as PCN-241.

The staff has reviewed your request and has concluded that it is not acceptable. The Safety Evaluation Report (SER) is provided as an enclosure to this letter.
