In accordance with the requirements of 10 CFR 72.48(d)(2), Florida Power & Light Company (FPL) hereby submits the summary report of changes, tests and experiments for the Turkey Point Nuclear Plant Independent Spent Fuel Storage Installation (ISFSI) subject to evaluation in accordance with 10 CFR 72.48(c)(2). A review has determined that there were no changes, tests or experiments conducted requiring evaluation since FPL completed the initial spent fuel transfer campaign to the ISFSI on December 7, 2011.

FPL is a general licensee pursuant to 10 CFR 72.210. Spent fuel transferred to the Turkey Point ISFSI, to date, has been conducted in accordance with Amendment 1 to Certificate of Compliance No. 1030.
