Re: Response to FEMA Report

Dear Mr. Grimes:

Following receipt by the City of San Juan Capistrano of a memorandum to you from John Dickey regarding the status of state and local emergency preparedness for the San Onofre Nuclear Generating Station, I feel compelled to comment on the conclusions and subsequent recommendations expressed in this document. San Juan Capistrano, as an active participant in the observed exercise, is somewhat perplexed with the findings in this correspondence to you in comparison with the findings distributed to those participating jurisdictions regarding the same exercise. Discrepancies in both evaluations as well as statements issued by FEMA personnel at the public hearing seem to have generated varied conclusions. In fact, prior to this memo the City's impression which seemed to be shared by the other participating jurisdictions was one of competency and capability in the administration of our emergency plans.

Admittedly, most of these plans require additional work to conform with all the new regulations effecting nuclear response planning. Much of this work is coordinated and progressing through an on-going Inter-Jurisdictional Task Force review. As revisions and updates occur, copies will be forwarded to FEMA for comment. Additionally, comments on the Evaluation Findings Exercise Report relating to City actions and perceived actions during the May 13th drill will be forthcoming. ]

It is the intent of this letter to advise you of the reviewing process currently underway by the local jurisdictions and request that these comments be considered by your agency prior to any statement of Emergency Preparedness status in this area. Thank you for your consideration in this matter. |
