Enclosed are three executed and thirty-seven conformed copies of Amendment Application No. 7 to Operating License NPF-10 for San Onofre Nuclear Generating Station, Unit 2. Amendment Application No. 7 consists of Proposed Change NPF-10-24 to Facility Operating License No. NPF-10, Technical Specifications incorporated as Appendix A.

Proposed Change NPF-10-24 is a request to revise Technical Specification 3.3.3.7, Table 3.3-11, FIRE DETECTION INSTRUMENTS MINIMUM INSTRUMENTS OPERABLE; and Technical Specification 3.7.8.2, Table 3.7-5, Safety Related Spray and/or Sprinkler Systems.

On July 9, 1982, Southern California Edison requested that the NRC approve part of Proposed Change NPF-10-24 to allow replacement of fire detection instrumentation inside containment prior to initial criticality which is expected to occur on July 20, 1982. Early approval was given on July 9, 1982 for changes to page 3/4 3-57 of Technical Specification 3.3.3.7, Table 3.3-11, FIRE DETECTION INSTRUMENTATION MINIMUM INSTRUMENTS OPERABLE.

It is respectfully requested that Amendment No. 7 be reviewed promptly and appropriate action taken. Direct distribution of Application No. 7 to Facility Operating License No. NPF-10 will be made in accordance with the service list provided by SCE's letter of March 30, 1982 to the Commission. An affidavit attesting to the fact that distribution has been completed will be submitted within ten days of amendment docketing.
