On May 25, 2010, PSEG Power, LLC and PSEG Nuclear, LLC (PSEG) submitted an Application for an Early Site Permit (ESP) for a site near Salem, New Jersey (the PSEG Site). On March 27, 2013, PSEG submitted revision 2 of the ESP application.

The Application contains an Environmental Report (Part 3) that describes the suitability of the PSEG Site to support construction and operation of up to two additional nuclear units relative to the impact on the environment. The ESP Environmental Report also describes the resultant impact on aquatic ecological resources.

In Reference 3, PSEG provided, at the NRC staff's request, a CD-ROM containing a copy of the *Draft Addendum to the Historic Properties Visual Impact Assessment* and preliminary *Draft Programmatic Agreement*. "Re: PSEG Early Site

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Permit Application, Salem County, Lower Alloways Township, New Jersey". The CD-ROM files in Enclosure 1 of Reference 3 were too large to be entered into ADAMS. Enclosure 1 to this letter provides a replacement CD-ROM containing the *Addendum to the Historic Properties Visual Impact Assessment* report with files of an appropriate size to be entered into ADAMS. PSEG requests that NRC replace the CD-ROM submitted in Reference 3 with the CD-ROM in Enclosure 1 and destroy the CD-ROM provided in Reference 3.
