**Subject:** Clarification questions regarding license renewal application dated September 20, 2013

I called Ms. Hartzell to ask her a couple of questions regarding the information contained in their renewal application.

1. The application did not include the model 4640 & 4640B devices as previously authorized. I asked her to confirm that she wanted these removed from their license. She confirmed that they wish to remove them from their license as they do not own any of these devices nor do they intend to get them in the future.
2. The application submittal contained a maximum possession limit for Americium-241 of 2500 millicuries. I reviewed the in-house criteria we use for total possession limit and mentioned that the requested limit would require security/ouo banners. She agreed that the request was for the total amount they would possess on all licenses nationwide and further stated that the maximum amount she could perceive in anyone time in NRC jurisdiction would be no more than 15 devices (660 mCi). I told her I would change the maximum amounts accordingly.

I told her everything else looked fine and that she should see the renewal in a couple of weeks.

I thank her for her time and ended the call.

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
