Semiannual Radioactive Effluent Release Report San Onofre Nuclear Generating Station, Unit 1

Environmental Technical Specification 5.6.2 of Provisional Operating License No. DPR-13 for San Onofre Nuclear Generating Station, Unit 1, requires a semiannual report of the radioactive content of effluents released to unrestricted areas and shipments of solid waste during the previous six months be submitted within sixty days after December 31, 1983. Pursuant to this requirement, the semiannual report for July I, 1983, through December 31, 1983, is enclosed.
