NRC to Hold Meeting With Energy Northwest on Columbia Generating Station

The Nuclear Regulatory Commission will hold a meeting with officials from Energy Northwest on Dec. 2 to discuss the licensee's initiatives and progress in improving human performance at the Columbia Generating Station. The plant is located near Richland, Wash.

The meeting, which will be open to public observation, will be held from 8 to 9:30 a.m. in the NRC's Region IV office at 1600 East Lamar Blvd., Arlington, Texas.

Energy Northwest officials will brief NRC staff on initiatives and progress in improving human performance issues detailed in the NRC's mid-cycle assessment letter issued Sept. 3
