Enclosed for your information is a Notice of Consideration of Issuance of Amendment to Provisional Operating License and Opportunity for Hearing. The notice relates to your request to revise Technical Specification 4.2, "Safety Injection and Containment Spray System Periodic Testing," to add a new surveillance requirement for the proposed trip of the safety injection and main feedwater pumps on low-low refueling water storage tank (RWST) level.

The proposed change would also revise the diesel generator load rejection surveillance test from 3220 Kw to 4000 Kw since the safety injection and feedwater pumps would be tripped simultaneously with the new trip circuit on low-low RWST level.

The Notice has been sent to Office of the Federal Register for publication.
