I am writing with regards to the disclosure/non-disclosure of quarterly reports for GL device transfers for Kanawha Scales & Systems.

I called and spoke with Larry Welch, Radiation Safety Officer and Analyzer Coordinator for the company (who is also cc'd on this email), at about 11:00AM today, November 14, 2013. Mr. Welch spoke with his supervisor and informed me that they do indeed wish for their quarterly reports to be withheld from public disclosure. I informed Mr. Welch that their company would need to procure an affidavit regarding this matter, that the requirements for this affidavit could be found in regulation 10 CFR 2.390(b)(1), and that we would need to receive a copy of this affidavit (at least in email form) within five (5) days in order for this report to remain non-public in its availability.
