SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA EDISON COMPANY and SAN DIEGO GAS
& ELECTRIC COMPANY, pursuant to 10 CFR 50.90, hereby submit
Amendment No. 95.

This amendment consists of Proposed Change No. 100 to
the Technical Specifications incorporated in Provisional
Operating License No. DPR-13 as Appendices A and B. Proposed
Change No. 100 is a request to revise Appendix A Technical
Specifications 2.1, "REACTOR CORE - Limiting Combination of
Power, Pressure, and Temperature," 3.5.2, "Control Group
Insertion Limits," and 3.11, "Continuous Power Distribution
Monitoring," to allow San Onofre Unit 1 to be operated as
described in the supporting report, "Reload Safety Evaluation,
San Onofre Nuclear Generating Station, Unit 1, Cycle 8,
Revision 1," dated October, 1980. This revision to the Reload
Safety Evaluation is provided to consider the impact of the
core flow reduction resulting from the steam generator
modifications now underway at San Onofre Unit 1.

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In the event of conflict, the information in this Amendment No. 95 supersedes the information previously submitted.

Accordingly, it is concluded that (1) the proposed changes do not involve an unreviewed safety question as defined in 10 CFR 50.59, nor do they present significant hazards considerations not described or implicit in the Final Safety Analysis, and (2) there is a reasonable assurance that the health and safety of the public will not be endangered by the proposed change.

Pursuant to 10 CFR 170.22, Proposed Change No. 100, submitted as Amendment No. 95, is determined to be a Class III change. The basis for this determination is that the change involves a single safety issue.

Accordingly, the fee of \$4,000.00 corresponding to this determination is remitted herewith as required by 10 CFR 170.22.
