SUBJECT: ISSUANCE OF SAFETY EVALUATION REPORT (SAN ONOFRE 2 AND 3)

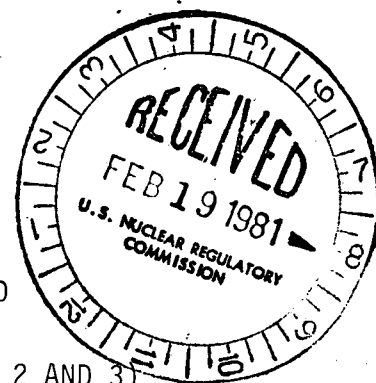
Enclosed for review by the Committee are twenty (20) copies of the Safety Evaluation Report prepared by the Office of Nuclear Reactor Regulation in the matter of the application filed by the Southern California Edison Company for licenses to operate the San Onofre Nuclear Generating Station, Units 2 and 3.

At this time, fifteen issues remain outstanding. These issues are identified in Section 1.7 of the SER. We anticipate that several of these will be resolved prior to the March 1981 ACRS meeting. Also, TMI-related issues are not covered in the SER. These issues will be addressed in an SER Supplement to be issued prior to the March 1981 ACRS meeting. We will require the resolution of all open items prior to a decision on issuance of operating licenses for San Onofre 2 and 3.
