Dear Dr. Lodhi,

As requested during your phone conversation on October 18th, with Erika Baldauff, the Natrium Plant RSO, please find a written follow up response to your question regarding waste associated with Mercury 197 (¹⁹⁷Hg) and Mercury 203 (²⁰³Hg) if those materials are removed from the material license.

There is no waste associated with the discontinuation of Mercury 203 and Mercury 197. Currently, none of these materials are on-site. The isotopes were previously utilized for conducting mercury inventory studies of electrolytic cells in our Chlor-Alkali plant based on isotopic dilution. The last study was conducted in 2009. During times when the studies were conducted, the contractor brought the materials on-site just prior to the event. All of the materials were then utilized or taken off-site by the contractor at the conclusion of each study.
