Without a federal repository for spent nuclear fuel, we are left with tons of high level nuclear waste for decades to come, sitting in our communities. A federal court said the EPA’s environmental impact studies must be done on storage, which forced the NRC to halt new reactor licensing and relicensing “until it established a technical basis for its belief that high-level radioactive waste will always be safely stored.” Do not create generic rules that treat all sites alike, whether the waste is on the banks of a river, lake, ocean, or on an earthquake fault. Leaving spent fuel in fuel pools indefinitely is not acceptable.
