RE: Uranium One Response to August 8, 2013 letter suspending review of the license amendment request for Ludeman Project – Docket No.: 04008502 Amendment Application to SUA 1341.

Dear Mr. Buckley:

Uranium One is currently working on finalizing the transfer of the Ludeman Project from Uranium One Americas, Inc. to Uranium One USA, Inc. Thus allowing Uranium One USA, Inc. to proceed with the license amendment to SUA-1341 for the Ludeman Project. Documents have been prepared to address; Wyoming State Leases, A Contribution Agreement, Assignments, Conveyance and Assumptions of Obligations, Mining Quitclaim Deed and Certificate of Non Foreign Status for this transfer. These documents will be recorded with the appropriate County, State and Federal agencies for the transfer of the Ludeman Project from Uranium One Americas, Inc., to Uranium One USA, Inc. Documentation on the transfer will be provided to the NRC once the transfer is completed to address concerns related to 10 CFR 40.44. Uranium One requests the NRC to provide what documentation is needed to satisfy conformance with 10 CFR 40.44.

Please find attached additional responses to Technical RAIs 3, 6, 7, 8, 14, 16, 24, 28, 30, 34, 36, 41, 42, 44, 57, 58, and 59 and Environmental RAIs WR-1 and WR-2 that were listed in the August 8, 2013 letter.


Uranium One is requesting additional clarification on what information NRC considers to be lacking for RAI-39 and RAI-58, that was not provided in the June 24, 2013 RAI response package and would request that Uranium One and NRC schedule a meeting to discuss these two RAI's.

One modification previously presented was the option to construct evaporation ponds to manage waste water (both 11e(2) and non 11e(2)) in addition to, or replacement of, deep disposal wells. Uranium One is currently developing the design package for the evaporation ponds option and will supplement the Amendment Application with this information in the near future. With the submittal of this correspondence and attached information, Uranium One believes the review by the NRC of the Ludeman Amendment Application document can resume at this time.
