Dear Mr. Miner:

I am responding to Ms. Angela L. Wright's, Security Technical Manager, Personnel Security Office, USEC Inc., letter dated October 8, 2013 (ACO 13-0047), requesting a U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) Foreign Ownership, Control or Influence (FOCI) determination for CRM Land Surveying LTD (CRM).

The NRC, in consultation with the U.S. Department of Energy, Oak Ridge Office, Office of Safeguards, Security, and Emergency Management, has completed its review of your submittal. Based on the information provided, the NRC has rendered a favorable FOCI determination. As a result, CRM is granted a non-possessing facility clearance to perform classified work under contract to USEC at the Secret-Restricted Data level. By letter dated November 13, 2013, Mr. Bernard W. Stapleton, NRC Office of Nuclear Security and Incidents Response, notified Mr. Charles Miller, Facility Security Officer, about this determination.

This action completes the efforts on Technical Assignment Control Number L34264.
