Gentlemen:

The U.S. Atomic Energy Commission hereby consents to the transfer to General Atomic Company of all rights, title, and interest of Gulf Oil Corporation in Facility Licenses R-33, R-67, R-100, XR-91 and Special Nuclear Material Licenses SNM-696, XSNM-367, XSNM-246, XSNM-428, XSNM-468, XSNM-473 and SNM-1409 held by the Gulf Oil Corporation; Facility Licenses R-49 and CX-25 and Materials Licenses SNM-33, SNM 871, SMB-293, and 24-17988-01 held by Gulf United Nuclear Fuels Corporation; and Facility License CPCSF-4 held by Allied-Gulf Nuclear Services, a partnership of which Gulf and Allied Chemical Nuclear Products, Inc. are general partners. This consent to the transfer of these licenses is made in response to your application by letter dated November 19, 1973. It is our understanding that General Atomic Company intends to continue without interruption the business performed under or in respect of said licenses by Gulf Energy and Environmental Systems, a division of Gulf, and that the General Atomic Company will assume all the rights, duties, responsibilities, liabilities and obligations of the Gulf Oil Corporation therein.

The Commission has found that:

- A. The application for transfer of Gulf's interest in the aforesaid licenses complies with the requirements of the Atomic Energy Act of 1954, as amended ("the Act"), and the Commission's regulations set forth in 10 CFR Chapter I;
- B. The transfer will not be inimical to the common defense and security or to the health and safety of the public;
- C. General Atomic Company is qualified to be the holder of the licenses;

- D. The transfer of the licenses is otherwise consistent with applicable provisions of law, regulations and orders issued by the Commission pursuant thereto.

In particular, with respect to the transfer of Gulf's interest in the facility licenses, the Commission has found that General Atomic Company is technically and financially qualified to conduct the activities authorized by the licenses and that General Atomic Company is not owned, controlled or dominated by an alien, a foreign corporation or a foreign government.

This consent is expressly subject to the provisions of the Resolution of the Standing Committee of the Partnership Committee of General Atomic Company adopted at a meeting thereof held on December 14, 1973, a copy of which was transmitted by letter dated December 14, 1973, from C. A. Rolander, Jr., President of General Atomic Company, to L. Manning Muntzing, Director of Regulation, United States Atomic Energy Commission.
