SUBJECT: 1993 EXERCISE SCOPE AND OBJECTIVES

This letter refers to your June 15, 1993, letter which enclosed the scope and objectives for the San Onofre Nuclear Generating Station annual emergency plan exercise scheduled for September 15, 1993.

We have completed our review of the scope and objectives. The results of our review were discussed during July 13 and 14, 1993, telephone conversations between Ms. G. Good, of my staff, and Mr. C. Anderson, of your staff. Mr. K. Bellis (NA&EP) participated in the July 14, 1993, call. I understand that during the second call, Mr. Bellis agreed to modify objectives 25 and 26 to clarify that SCE would perform a support function in the activities covered in the two objectives. I also understand that Mr. Anderson agreed to include the revised objectives in the final scenario package.

We contacted the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA), Region IX, during our review. Mr. R. Echavarria had no comments for us to relay to you.

Based on the results of our review, and the actions planned by your staff, we concluded that the exercise scope and objectives were consistent with your emergency plan goals and requirements.
