On May 8, 1991, the California Public Utilities Commission (CPUC), voted to deny the merger between Southern California Edison (SCE) and San Diego Gas & Electric (SDG&E). After reviewing the decision, SCE and SDG&E will not appeal the CPUC decision. SCE and SDG&E have agreed to terminate the merger agreement and withdraw pending regulatory approval requests. Accordingly, SCE hereby withdraws the merger amendment request submitted to the NRC on April 28, 1989 (Referenced).
