This amendment application consists of Proposed Change No. (PCN) 264, which requests an extension in the expiration date of the SONGS 1 license.

As specified in Section 2.F of the license, the license expires on March 2, 2004. PCN 264 requests that Section 2.F be amended by extending the expiration date to May 12, 2024.
