
Reference: Letter from Mr. S. A. Richards (USNRC) to
Harold B. Ray (SCE), dated January 26, 1993

The referenced letter forwarded a Notice of Violation (NOV) resulting from the NRC inspection conducted from December 1, 1992 through January 8, 1993, at the San Onofre Nuclear Generating Station, Units 1, 2, and 3. This inspection was documented in NRC Inspection Report Nos. 50-206/92-34, 50-361/92-34, and 50-362/92-34.

The letter transmitting the NOV indicated that a Southern California Edison (SCE) response was required which provides specific actions we have taken and any additional actions planned to prevent recurrences. The purpose of this letter is to document our discussion with Region V personnel (H. Wong, C. Caldwell, and D. Solorio) that an SCE response to the NOV is no longer required since the information has already been discussed in the inspection report.
