By letters dated March 30, 1989 and September 6, 1989, Southern California Edison Company, et al., responded to Bulletin 88-10. As a result of Supplement 1 to Bulletin 88-10, corrections to your previous submittals were required and were forwarded by letters dated November 16, 1989 and March 12, 1990. Additionally, you stated that you would submit a report that summarizes the results of molded case circuit breaker tests. Your schedule for reporting is summarized as follows: Unit 1, Cycle 11 refueling outage; Unit 2, Cycle 5 refueling outage; and Unit 3, Cycle 5 refueling outage. By letter dated January 4, 1990, you supplied the Unit 2 report.

In your responses, you confirmed that activities required to address the issue of substandard molded case circuit breakers discussed in Bulletin 88-10 have been substantially performed, with the remaining actions to be performed on an acceptable schedule. A detailed technical review of the your responses has not been performed. However, the area may be subject to inspection at a later date. If a subsequent inspection identifies deficiencies in the your actions and responses, this issue will be reopened. Presently, the staff considers this action complete.
