### **NOTIFICATION OF UPDATES TO STATE LIAISON OFFICER PROGRAM WEB PAGES (FSME-13-122)**

**Purpose:** To provide: 1) notification that available presentation materials for the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC)'s 2013 National State Liaison Officers (SLO) Conference have been posted on the conference web page; and 2) a reminder of the updated main SLO Program web page.

**Background:** On November 5-6, 2013, NRC hosted the 2013 National SLO Conference at the agency's headquarters in Rockville, MD. Following the conference on November 7, 2013, NRC held an optional training session on "Effective Communications of Nuclear Information." This conference is held every two years to serve as a forum for States and the agency to discuss topics of mutual interest. Staff recently updated the conference web page as well as the main SLO Program web page.

**Discussion:** Available presentations, along with some photographs from the event, have been posted on the conference web page (<http://homer.ornl.gov/nrc/conf/>). In addition, staff recently updated the main SLO Program web page (<http://www.nrc.gov/about-nrc/state-tribal/fst-liaison.html#state>) to provide a consolidated location for SLO Program related information. This revised web page contains useful information for SLOs, such as program background and applicable policies and procedures. In addition, it contains links to SLO contacts and letter listings, associated social media entries (e.g., a Blog article and YouTube video), and the 2011 and 2013 National SLO Conference web pages.
