Subject: Oconee License Amendment Request - Acceptance Review Determination

Sandra,

By letter dated October 24, 2013, Duke Energy Carolinas, LLC (Duke) submitted a license amendment request (LAR) to revise the Standby Shutdown Facility Quality Requirements for Oconee Nuclear Station, Units 1, 2, and 3. The LAR supports replacement of the Unit 1 Pressurizer Heater Bundles during the Fall 2014 outage to mitigate an Alloy 600 concern.

The purpose of this e-mail is to provide the results of the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) staff's acceptance review.

The acceptance review was performed to determine if there is sufficient technical information in scope and depth to allow the NRC staff to complete its detailed technical review. The acceptance review is also intended to identify whether the application has any readily apparent information insufficiencies in its characterization of the regulatory requirements or the licensing basis of the plant.

The NRC staff has reviewed the application and concludes that it does provide technical information in sufficient detail to enable the NRC staff to complete its detailed technical review and make an independent assessment regarding the acceptability of the proposed amendment in terms of regulatory requirements and the protection of public health and safety and the environment. Given the lesser scope and depth of the acceptance review as compared to the detailed technical review, there may be instances in which issues that impact the NRC staff's ability to complete the detailed technical review are identified despite completion of an adequate acceptance review.
