This email is to document that verbal notification was given to your office on 12-6-13 of a reportable release on Permit 603, NRC Source Material License SUA-1548. The release happened on Thursday, 12-5-13 at approximately 11:30 pm. The data reported was as follows:

• Location: Surge tank at Vollman Deep Injection Well

- Fluid release estimated at 891 gallons of permitted waste water onto ground surface. No fluid entered into waters of the state. All 891 gallons of the released water froze on the surface and was recovered as ice. A sample for uranium content is pending.
- Cause was a malfunctioning level indicator on the tank which allowed an overflow condition. Indicator was repaired and the disposal system remains in operation.

The WDEQ-WQD was given verbal notification and a report will be filed with the WQD spill database.

A written notification will be sent out on or before Friday, December 13, 2013.
