On December 20, 2013, Ms. Tara Inverso, of the NRC, and Mr. David Bradish, of the Nuclear Energy Institute (NEI), participated in a telephone conversation. The following items were discussed:  - Ms. Inverso provided answers to questions Mr. Bradish asked in a previous phone call.
